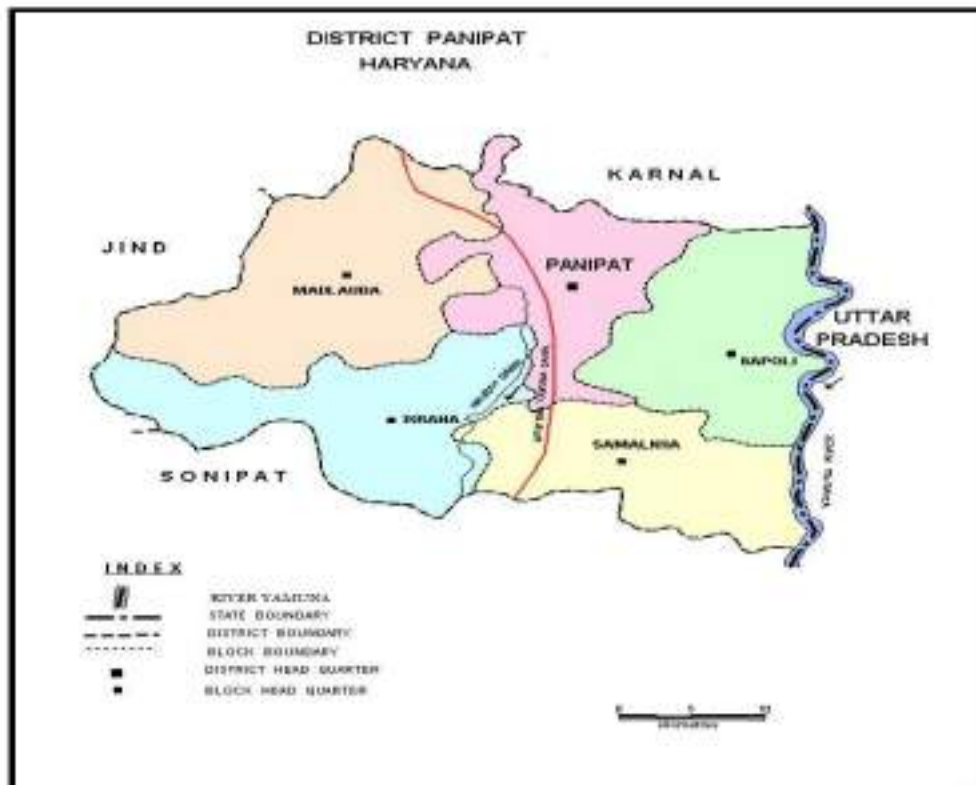

CHAPTER-1

INTRODUCTION

1.1 Geographical setting of the district

Panipat district is an ancient and historic city in, Haryana State, India. Panipat was one of the five cities (Prasthas) founded by the Pandava brothers during the period of the Mahabharata; the historic name of Panipat was **Panduprastha**. Three battles fought at the city were pivotal in Indian History.

Panipat is traditionally a commercial and industrial center. It is situated on Sher Shah Suri Marg (NH-1) and the district came into existence from 1st January 1992.

Panipat lying in the east central part of the Haryana State is located between 29°23'N 76°58'E and 29.39°N 76.97°E at an average altitude of 219 Meters from the Sea Level. It has a geographical area of 1, 30,000 hectare. According to 2001 Census, population of Panipat district is 9, 67,449. And total no. of villages is 198 in the district. Panipat District Boundaries touch other Districts of Haryana - Karnal in the North, Jind in the West and Sonapat in the South. The East side of the Panipat finds the state of Uttar Pradesh across Yamuna. The distance of River Yamuna from Panipat City is about 18 Km.

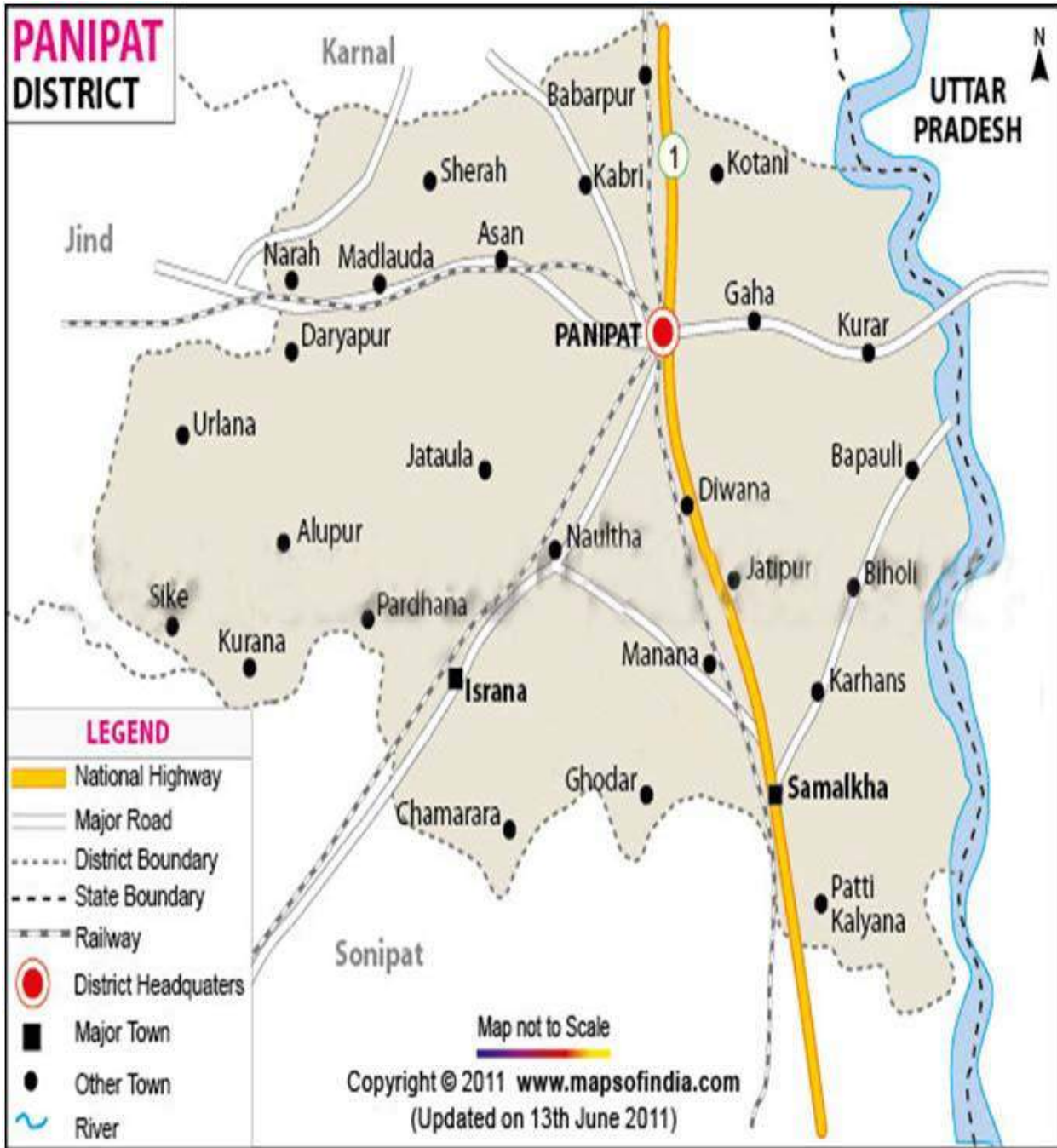

CHAPTER-2

Drainage System

2.1 Drainage system in the District

The District lies in the indo Gangetic plain area. It slopes from north east to south west, but in eastern part slope is from north to south. The plain is a flat area. The only Perennial River Yamuna makes eastern boundary of the district. The district possesses a good network of canals emanating from Western Yamuna Canal (Delhi Branch) which passes through the centre of the district in north south direction. All the distributaries depend upon this canal for water requirement. The canal takes off from Yamuna River at Tajewala and strong masonry weir is built.

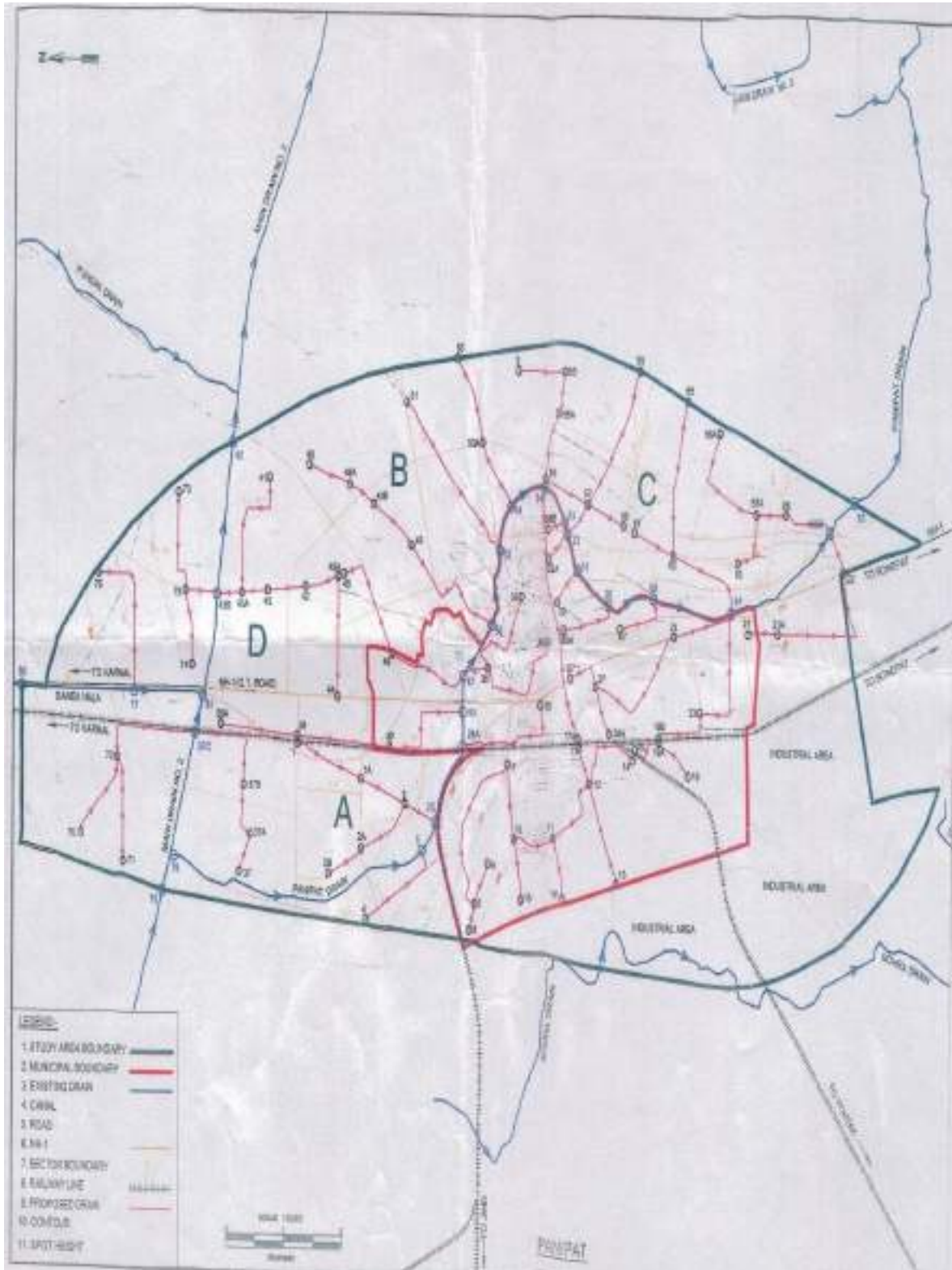

3.2 Flood risk and causes of flood in the district

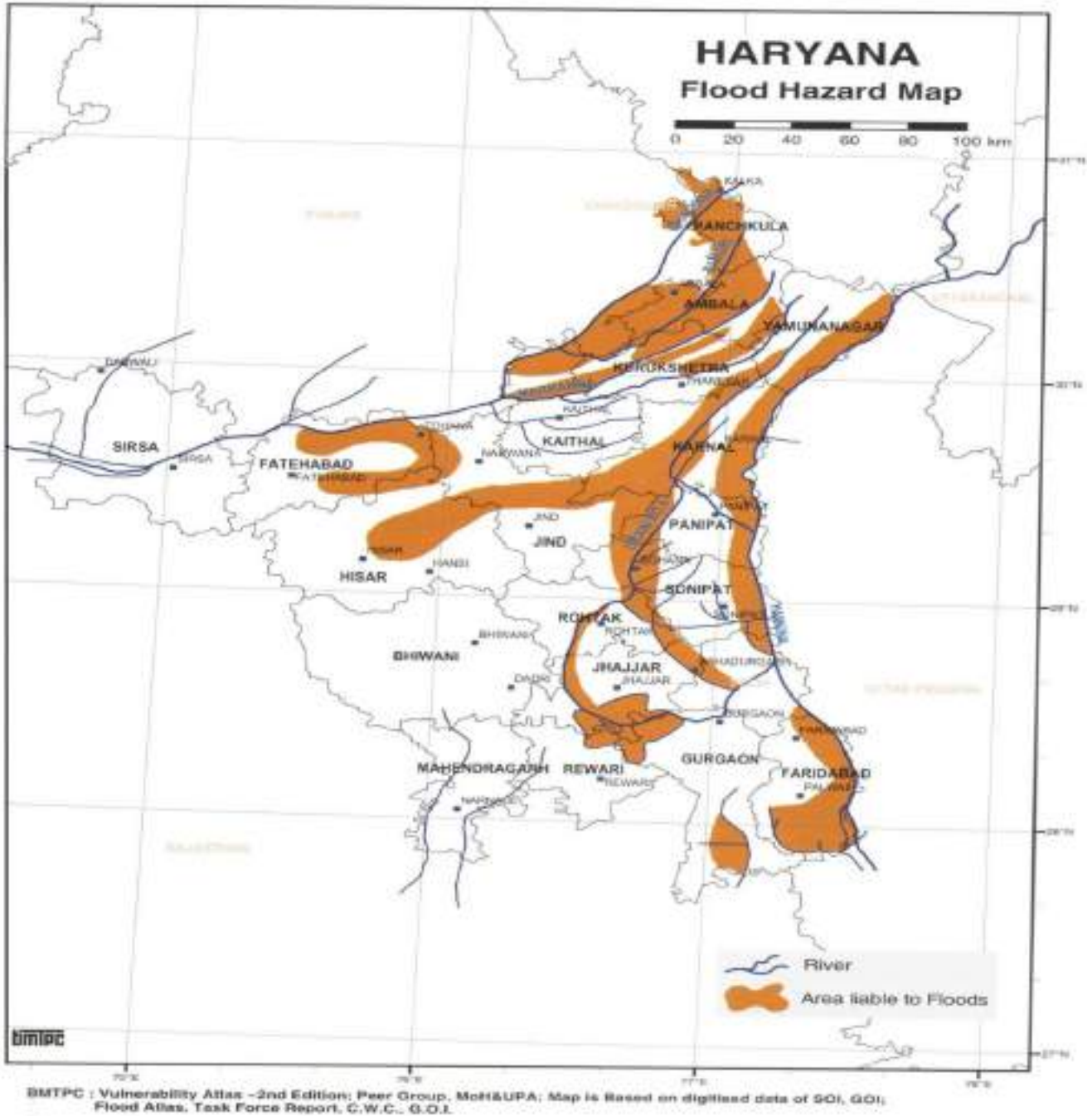
The main reason behind flood is excessive discharge in Yamuna. The normal average discharge in this river is 1,00,000 Cusecs but sometimes due to heavy rainfall in the hilly area, the discharge increases up to 3,00,000-6,00,000 Cusecs. In 2013 floods, discharge in river Yamuna increased abruptly from 160 cusecs on June 15, 2013 to 37,176 cusecs on June 16, 2013. This further increased to a peak discharge of 8, 06,444 cusecs on June 17, 2013 and in 2018 Discharged 8,28,000 cus leading to breach in the Yamuna and submerged area. Below table 1.4 shows a comparative analysis of Rainfall and discharge (Lac Cusecs) in Yamuna for last 8 years and 3.2 shows discharge and flood risk. Besides this, there are several pockets of low-lying areas such as Panipat Town, some villages of Bapoli & Samalkha block in the district from which natural flow of rainwater is not possible which results into accumulation of surface as well as the ground water and got submerged . Haryana is covered by two main Drainage basins: The Yamuna basin of 16,330 km² or 37% of the area of the State, the Ghaggar basin (Part of Indus Basin) of 27882 km² or 63% of the area of the State. The drainage conditions in each of the two zones are as follows:

The Yamuna Basin The eastern part of the State (the Yamuna Basin) has the most elaborate drainage network comprising about 350 main and tributary drains of a total length of 3,000 km. Yet the system is still not capable of draining accumulated surface water from all lands sufficiently fast and, following heavy rains during the monsoon season, there are many pockets of standing water, which can be attributed mainly to non construction of the field drains at micro level.

The Ghaggar Basin (Part of Indus Basin) The Ghaggar basin covers an area of 27882 km² or 63 % of Haryana's area in the districts of Ambala, Kurukshetra (in part), Kaithal, Fatehabad, Sirsa, Jind, Hisar, Bhiwani, and Mahendragarh. The Ghaggar River runs along the boundary between Haryana and Punjab states, crossing it at several points. Though less severe than in the Yamuna Zone, flooding in this Zone is exacerbated by cross-Ghaggar inflows (from the Punjab) in the districts of Kaithal, Fatehabad and Sirsa. Constructed embankments along Ghaggar River and its tributaries have reduced the frequency of inundation but not eliminated it as heavy rainfall and inflows across the Ghaggar River, still persist.

Floods have been recurrent phenomenon in Panipat. It is because of presence of only perennial River of Haryana i.e. Yamuna, flows almost along with entire eastern boundary of the District besides this, there are several pockets of low-lying areas such as Panipat Town, some villages of Bapoli & Samalkha block in the district from which natural flow of rainwater is not possible which results into accumulation of surface as well as the ground water and got submerged.

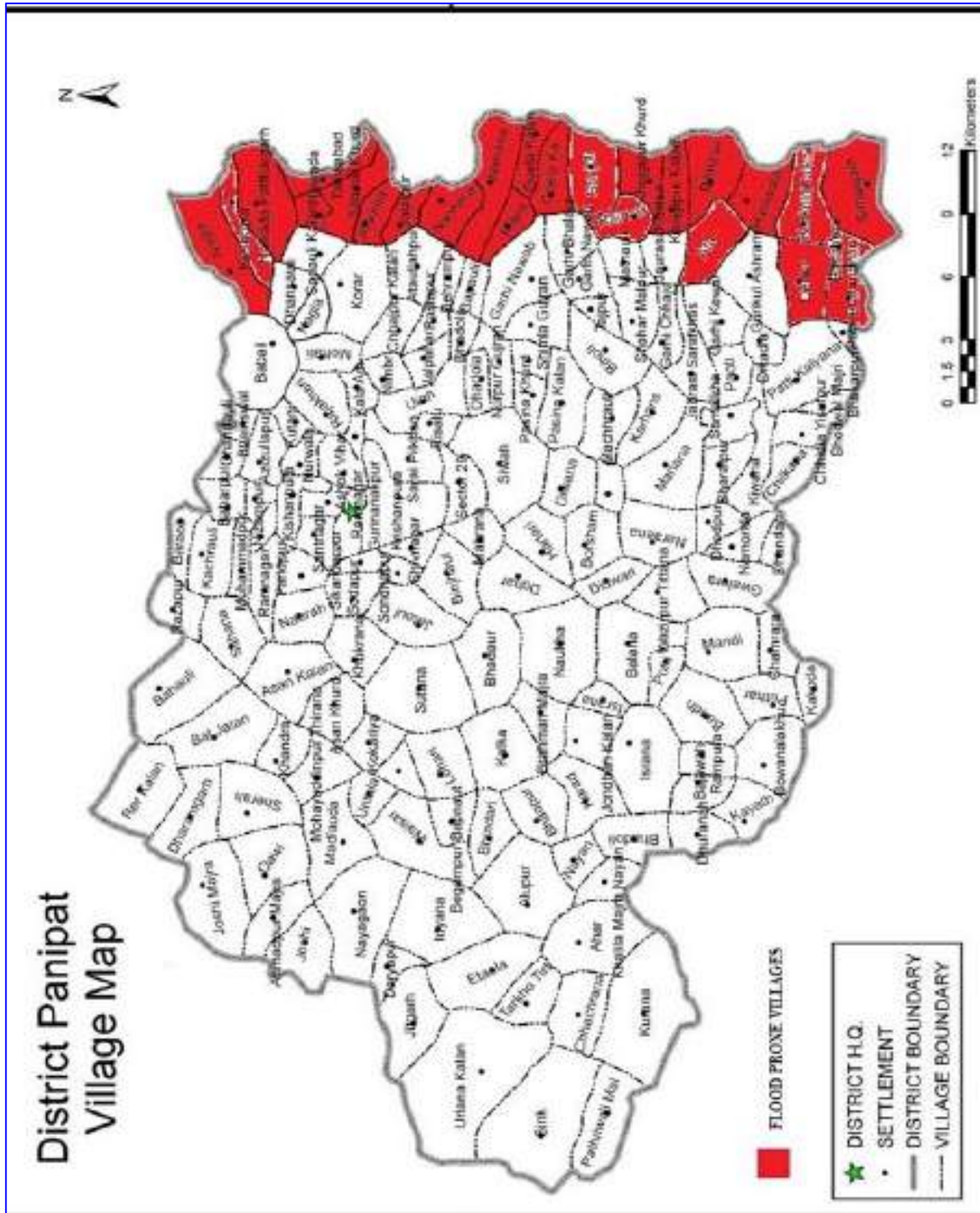

CHAPTER-5
FLOOD ACTION PLAN

5.1 Set up of flood control room:

For tackling flood emergency in the district, the District **Flood Control Room** has been set up in the Deputy Commissioner Office under the charge of District Revenue Officer, Panipat from 22-05-20 to 30-09-18 in compliance with the order of Additional Chief Secretary and Financial Commissioner to Govt. Haryana, Revenue and Disaster Management Department orders. Similar flood control rooms will also be set up at Tehsil headquarters and the concerned Tehsildar will be in charge. Keeping in view that the sensitivity of flood in Bapoli areas a full fledged Control Room will be set in the office of the B.D & P.O Bapoli who will be in charge. The detail of flood control rooms is shown in **(Table 5.1)**

(a) Activities of Flood Control Room-The Flood Control room will Monitor activities like -

- ✓ Evacuation of dangerously exposed or seriously flooded villages.
- ✓ Organize relief measures through the various relief centres.
- ✓ Co-ordinate the participation of social organizations and agencies both in evacuation and relief operations.
- ✓ It will also guide and inform all those who may seek assistance or information of flood situations.
- ✓ It will keep close liaison with the Zonal and sector officers to whom urgent information of floods will immediately be sent for necessary action.

Liaison will be maintained between the Districts, Tehsil control Room and various Zonal Sector Officer through messengers who mostly consist of Tehsil, Block, Peons, village Chowkidar and voluntary organizations. Other means of communications via, Telegram's, Telephones etc will also be used where possible for the proper distribution of gratuitous relief viz. food, medicine/clothes, match Boxes candle etc amongst the people of marooned villages.

The report of flood situation would be daily conveyed to FCR and Commissioner, Karnal division and other concerned authorities daily at 06:00 P.M by wireless (police) and NIC.

5.2 Pre-flood Inspection

The following works were inspected:-

Flood Agenda: - protection against erosion of agriculture land of Dadlana village from flood and waste water is flowing in Munak Drain by providing lining from RD 27360 to 28950.

This flood agenda has been approved in 48th meeting of HSDR& FCB as Medium Term scheme. The work has been completed.

5.3 Flood Warning System

The flood warning system is issued by S.D.O Tajewala Headwork’s in the event of heavy discharge in River Yamuna Telegraphically or by wireless to the office of Deputy Commissioner, which further convey to the Sub- Divisional Officer at Panipat, Samalkha, Tehsildar/Naib Tehsildar, officer of the water services department and all other departments in the Panipat District for keeping watch over the flood under their jurisdiction. Immediately on receipt of high Floods warning exceeding 2.50 lacs Cs the Deputy Commissioner is to be informed through the quickest means by the office in charge at Tajewala Headwork. Likewise the Superintendent of police is also to be informed who will arrange police squads to be dispatched to the dangerous zones. The S.D.O, Tehsildars, Naib Tehsildars and B.D & P.O’s would be immediately alerted to dispatch information to the Zonal/Sector Officers of the zones/areas in danger and they in turn will alert the Panchayat concerned. The Tehsildars, Naib Tehsildars and B.D & P.O’s would ensure that the ferry boats are made available during the emergency. The D.P.R.O Panipat would keep on loud speaker duly fitted with his jeep for announcement in the villages regarding the warning of flood in river Yamuna.

In Addition to this Toll free No 1077 has been established at DC Camp office and round the clock duty has been assigned on it. An officer(or An officer not below the rank of Assistant along with one clerk and peon shall be put on duty by the officer In-charge at all hour during the raining season for the purpose of receiving public message and police radio message(wireless). In case of grave emergency, assistant of Indian army and Indian Air Force may also be seeking.

- 3 **Mirzapur Complex**: - It was informed during inspection by the Xen/Panipat W/S Division Panipat that there is proposal of repair of 5 No. Old Stone Studs and 275 Ft long Constructing Revetment U/S of Stud No. 10 approved in the meeting of 51st meeting of HSDR&FCB for providing protection to Mirzapur complex. The stone bolder supply has been completed and the dumping of stone is in progress and the work will be completed before 15.07.2020.

5.6 Responsibility of various concerned departments before, during and after Flood**(a) Arrangements of filled sand bags, kassies (spades) tokries (baskets):**

The Irrigation department will be fully responsible to keep 5 thousands filled sandbags and 100 labourers readily available for use in emergency. In addition to this all the B.D. & P.O should also make available sufficient no. of tokries and kassies for use at time of emergency by involving Panchayati raj institutions.

(b) Provision of dewatering operation of flood /rain water:

Irrigation Department will be responsible to carry out dewatering operation from abadi as well as fields; active assistance will be provided to the Irrigation department by the S.D.O and sector officers for speedy dewatering operations. It has already been mentioned that the Drainage work taken up during the current year will be completed well in time. Xen, Public Health and Joint Commissioner, M.C will be responsible for dewatering operation within M.C Limit. For dewatering of flood/rainy water the availability of pumps both electric/diesel will be made by the executive engineer, public health, Panipat/Mechanical Division Karnal. These departments will

be entirely held responsible for any complaint with regard to dewatering operations; hence, they should keep ready sufficient number of pumps in order to face any eventuality of flood. The detail of pumps available with the executive Engineer, Irrigation and Executive engineer, Public Health is shown in **table (5.7)**

(c) Provision of distribution of Essential Commodities

The District Food and Supply Controller Panipat will make elaborate arrangement for supply of essential commodities such as wheat, Atta, rice, Sugar, Cooking Oil, Kerosene oil, petrol, Diesel, Tea leaves etc in all flood affected villages. It will be the responsibility of Distt. Food and Supply Controller will ensure sufficient supply of these commodities to the affected villages of the Distt. Through, the existing network of fair price shops.

In case of requirement of tents/sirkies the DFSC will also be responsible for the supply to the flood affected persons. The District Manager CONFED Panipat will also make similar arrangement for the supply of essential articles in the flood affected areas during the floods.

(d) Provision of Health coverage to affected population

The civil surgeon Panipat / District Malaria Officer Panipat will be responsible for ensuring health coverage to the affected population, for this purpose, major efforts will be required by the civil Surgeon firstly to prevent the possibility of outbreak of any epidemic. Intensive anti-Malaria spray will be carried out in all flood affected villages of the District.

The Civil Surgeon Panipat will ensure that sufficient medicines are made available with all the medical Centres/ Primary Health centre to meet any eventuality that may arise during flood. Flood Control Room will also be set up in the Civil Hospital Panipat and S.M.O office Samalkha under the Supervision of S.M.O/ Medical Superintendent.

(e) Provision of Drinking Water

The executive engineer, Public Health Panipat will be make arrangements for carrying out Super-Chlorination of all rural water supply schemes. In the event of floods, arrangement of sufficient number of hand pumps will be made by the Executive Engineer, Public Health Panipat which will be installed in flood affected villages as per situation. Normally during flood all hand pumps, well and other sources are polluted and scarcity of drinking water prevails, hence Xen Public Health should make arrangement for supply of fresh chlorinated water to the affected people.

Similarly arrangements will be made by the Executive Engineer Public Health Panipat for digging of trench type latrines in villages which might be marooned by floods.

(f) Preventive steps for the care of livestock's population during flood

The Deputy Director Animal Husbandry Panipat will provide pre flood veterinary aid for the animals; cattle's to avoid any out-break of disease during the flood. He will arrange and provide assistance to the cattle population so as to prevent the spreading of any epidemic and other diseases in the area.

The Deputy Director Animal Husbandry Panipat will ensure the availability of different vaccines in sufficient quantity. He will further supply list of relief posts along with the staff put on duty.

(g) Communication information regarding flood situation

Wireless sets will be installed at Pathargarh, Rana majra, Nanhera, Ramra, Rakshera and Bilaspur. The Superintendent of police, Panipat would ensure the installation of these wireless sets well in time. The S.P would ensure that the staff put on wireless duty on these points remains present all the 24 hours during the rainy season and send flood situation report to Distt. Control room, Sector Officers S.D.O and Deputy Commissioner in time.

(h) Zonation of flood prone area

In order to face the problem arising out of floods the entire district has been divided into Zones & Sectors. There will be two zones in the district i.e. Panipat and Samalkha. The Sub-Divisional Officer Panipat will be overall in charge of Panipat Zone and SDO Samalkha will be overall in charge of Samalkha Zone. Both these Zones have further been divided into sectors under the charge of sector officers. There will be five sectors in each zone. The zonal officers

and the sector officers will be responsible for the distribution of flood relief, providing shelter, evacuation and for providing the cooked food and other essential commodities in the respective areas.

The Tehsildars will be responsible for the supply of food relief material to the sector officers. A proper co-ordination will maintained between the Tehsildars and sector officers so that the quick and timely relief is provided to the flood affected persons. The sector officer will take charge of the relief material like boats, life saving jackets, and petrol etc well in advance and keep these materials ready for use during the floods, they will send daily reports of flood situation in their area to the Zonal Officers and the Zonal Officers will apprise the Deputy Commissioner daily. The S.H.O of the concerned police stations will remain in touch with them and use the wireless sets for transmission of the information immediately to the concerned authorities. i) Relief and Evacuation Centre

The evacuation centre, Flood Relief Equipments and trained manpower available in the district has been shown in **chapter -6** It will be entire responsibility of the Sector Officer to shift the affected population along with their belongings cattle etc to these centres. In case of floods, evacuation is to be carried out by the every available means in the village i.e. by carts, tractors, buggies etc as well as by boats and automobiles which will be made available by the Sub-Divisional Officer, Panipat/Samalkha, Tehsildar and BD& PO's as and when required. All village situated in dangerously exposed areas will be informed about the evacuation set up. It will be the duty of Sector Officers to inform the inhabitants. The Tehsildars/Naib Tehsildars / B.D. & P.O Bapoli will select safe place on high level for evacuation of the affected persons.

The Officer-in-charge of each relief centre will also constantly remain in touch with their Zonal Officers and will inform about the situation and arrangements made by them to the S.D.O's, Panipat/Samalkha and Distt. Revenue Officer/Deputy Commissioner, Panipat.

(j) Provision of funds for carrying out relief operation

Necessary funds for relief operation are provided by the State Govt. every Year under head 2245 Relief on account on Natural calamities for providing to the flood affected persons and for taking other necessary relief measures. The officers entrusted with the work of distribution of grant and other relief will maintain proper account of the expenditure and other meant for distribution to flood affected peoples. This is however subject to audit. In case of requirement of more funds reference is made to the quarter concerned.

(n) Preparedness measures for COVID-19 in case of Flood

While all the above preparedness measures are undertaken, it is necessary to keep in mind that we will be preparing and responding to disasters amidst our fight against COVID-19 (containment, preparedness, treatment etc.). Hence, the following additional precautions/ measures should be taken while we prepare for floods/ urban floods:

- a) Checking whether quarantine/isolation facilities are located in the flood prone areas and if necessary, moving them to safe areas or taking measure to ensure that they are not affected by floods.
- b) During mass evacuation in case of flood, necessary measures need to be taken to ensure physical distancing, avoiding over-crowding, wearing necessary face masks by all etc.

- c) Due to the need to maintain physical distancing, there will considerable reduction in the capacity of the flood shelters to accommodate evacuated/ affected people. Keeping this in mind, the capacity of flood shelters needs to be reworked and additional shelters need to be identified and prepared well in advance. Also, additional toilets and other arrangements also need to be made even in the existing shelters to ensure that COVID-19 spread does not happen in the flood shelters or relief camps. Adequate feeding in the shelters.
- d) Regular medical checkups are required in the camps/ shelters to ensure that people with symptoms are isolated and treated so that COVID-19 spread can be prevented.
- e) The first responders and staff involved in disaster evacuation, rescue and relief activities (Police/SDRF/Fire Services/Home Guards/ Civil Defense or any other volunteer) should wear adequate personal protective equipment (PPE). Hence, the State Governments should assess the need for PPEs for disaster management purposes and make arrangements for the same.
- f) Management of concurrent disaster of flood and COVID-19 will need additional infrastructure, human and material resources and revision of our preparedness and response plans. Hence the District Administrations should rework the requirement of resources for managing flood in the light of the existing COVID-19 pandemic situation.
